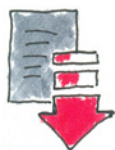

BREAKOUT SESSIONS

There will be **six parallel breakout sessions** held on Day 2 on the following focus topics. Participants will choose their session on Day 1. You will be invited to share your personal views and develop a joint vision on the questions of your breakout session in a creative morning breakout session. Using participatory methods, you will jointly develop concrete points of action towards your focus topic in the afternoon session.

Alternatively to choosing a breakout session, participants may volunteer as harvesters for the **cross cutting topics** and will be introduced to this task in detail on Day 1.



Working for change:

how to build a gender sensitive economy with equal opportunities?

In this breakout session you will touch upon questions like:

- How can we ensure that women and men can equally participate in and shape the European economy?
- What if people's skills and competences mattered more than their gender for their salaries?
- Which steps shall be taken in order to strengthen societal and monetary recognition of care work?



Relationship goals:

how to break the stereotypes about relationships and sexuality?

This breakout session will inspire discussions on questions like:

- How to build gender equal relationships?
- What if a person's gender identity and sexuality just didn't make a difference any more in our societies?
- How can sex education help to break with the taboo of talking about sex?
- What is needed to put an end to all forms of sexual violence?



Switch off the power:

how to address gender-based violence?

In this breakout session, participants will be discussing questions like:

- What helps to speak about all forms of violence more openly?
- What is needed to address the different forms of violence separately and as a structural pattern?
- How could the legal framework be improved in order to effectively protect persons from violence?



Educating equally: how to ensure careers are gender equal?

In this breakout session, you will touch upon questions like:

- What if gender equality was addressed from a very young age on and at all stages of education?
- What do curricula in gender sensitive schools and universities look like?
- How will apprenticeship systems become gender equal?
- How can we strengthen teachers' and educators' awareness for gender equality?



Vote for representative voices: how to make politics truly diverse?

This breakout session will inspire discussions on questions like:

- How can we ensure that women and men can equally participate in and shape politics?
- What helps to strengthen equal representation of women and men in political leadership positions?
- What if gender equality was a political priority in the EU and the Member States?



Deleting digital discrimination: how to make our media gender sensitive?

In this breakout session, participants will be discussing questions like:

- What does gender equality in the media look like?
- How can women and men equally benefit from opportunities of digital media?
- What if we used social media to strengthen gender equality?
- How can we overcome the gender stereotypes of a photoshopped online world?
